- Are open to the public. Everyone with an interest in the subject is welcome to attend.

Working Group Topics

There are six working groups covering important transportation subjects. Participate in as many as you are interested in.

1. **Major Corridors and Intersections**
2. **Neighborhood Livability**
3. **Transit**
4. **Bicycle and Pedestrian**
5. **Industrial and Freight**
6. **Downtown**

Meeting Format & Schedule

Each group will meet approximately three times to talk about the Transportation System Plan.

- **Meeting 1** of each Working Group: **February 28 - March 9**
- **Meeting 2** of each Working Group: **April 2- 12**
- **Meeting 3** of each Working Group: **June 4 - June 15**

The Transit Working Group will discuss both the Transportation System Plan and Linking Tualatin and will have two additional meetings: **February 9 and June 28.**
