The Year of Transportation Working Groups

Working Groups are discussion groups focused around a specific transportation issue. Working Groups:

- Offer an opportunity for deeper discussion and deliberation with a smaller group of participants.
- Generate ideas and transportation solutions to be considered by the City Council, Transportation Task Force, and public.
- Are open to the public. Everyone with an interest in the subject is welcome to attend.

Working Group Topics

There are six working groups covering important transportation subjects. Participate in as many as you are interested in. Each group will meet approximately three times to talk about the Transportation System Plan.

First Meetings: Discuss needs and deficiencies within Tualatin's transportation system; brainstorm potential solutions and future transportation projects.

- **Downtown** - February 28 at 6:00pm, City Operations Department, 10699 SW Herman Rd.
- **Bicycle and Pedestrian** - February 29 at 6:00pm, Tualatin Police Department, 8650 SW Tualatin Rd.
- **Major Corridors and Intersections** - March 1 at 6:00pm, Tualatin Police Department
- **Neighborhood Livability** - March 5 at 6:00pm, Tualatin Police Department
- **Transit** - March 8 at 6:00pm, Tualatin Police Department

Second Meetings: (April 2 - 12) Meetings will refine project ideas; eliminate projects that don't work; identify those which have the greatest potential.

Third Meetings: (June 4 - 15) Meetings will evaluate projects; consider Transportation Task Force and community feedback; further refine and prioritize recommendations.

The Transit Working group has two additional meetings for discussion of Linking Tualatin topics: February 9 and June 28.
