## Transit Working Group

We need people in Tualatin with ideas about how to improve transit service. Can you help?

**When:** The Transit Working Group will meet up to seven (7) times. You are encouraged to attend all meetings, but regular participation is not required.

**Schedule:** Monthly meetings through June. The first meeting will be **February 9th** from 5-7 p.m. at the Tualatin Police Station.

**Who:** Interested task force members, transit users and anyone else with an interest in enhancing future transit services in Tualatin.

**What:** Subjects the group will work on include:

- Are there any key transit connections missing in Tualatin?
- Advise on current transit service needs and deficiencies city-wide.
- Identify opportunities or constraints to future transit service.
- Identify necessary projects or strategies for improving transit service.
- Review reports and study documents for accuracy.
- Review and comment on draft Linking Tualatin Plan.
